CENTRE COUNTY DUI TREATMENT COURT OVERVIEW 3d OFFENSE- HIGHEST TIER BAC (>.16%)

DUI Treatment Court is a rehabilitation based alternative sentencing program that is available to individuals facing a third DUI, particularly individuals facing a third offense/highest tier offense. There is a \$500 application fee which will be applied to the individual's cost and fines.

A third offense/highest tier DUI is a misdemeanor of the first degree. The mandatory minimum sentence upon conviction is 1-5 years minimum imprisonment with a \$2,500 fine and an 18 month minimum license suspension. The 1-5 year sentence may be served in either County jail or State Prison. As a rule of thumb in Centre County, upon conviction for third offense/highest tier those individuals that do not apply for DUI court will be sentenced to state prison.

As an alternative, a sentence under the Centre County DUI Court program is for five years of Intermediate Punishment to be served as follows:

- One year restrictive intermediate punishment consisting of:
 - 90 days to be served at Centre County Correctional Facility (work release eligible)
 - The balance (275 days) to be served on house arrest w/electronic monitor
- *Following house arrest, 6 months trans-dermal alcohol monitor*
- DUI Court every other Thursday for minimum of 2 years (or until completion/graduation)
- Outpatient or inpatient rehabilitation
- *Mandatory attendance at AA meetings*
- \$2,500 fine plus court costs of roughly \$1,000
- \$12 per day for electronic monitor fee $(275 \times $12 = $3,300)$
